- \* Susan Rolke will be doing her talk on Chile at the Jaffrey Library soon, but no date has been set yet.
- \* Susan Rolke will be conducting her Chile talk at the Moore Free Library in Newfane, VT on Sunday May 31<sup>st</sup> at 3pm.

**Old Business:**

- \* Saturday November 29<sup>th</sup> at 7am on WKBK 1290 AM radio Susan Rolke's interview about her trip to Chile will be aired. **Susan indicated the 22 minute interview when well with many basic questions and short answers. Susan indicated the interview was recorded and when she receives the recording she will send it to us. There maybe a follow up interview, which will be more in depth questions.**
- \* Observatory work items needing to be completed is the replacement of the rotted sill plate at the observatory entrance, removal of the remaining trees on the south barrier, painting a second coat of paint on the observatory trim, fixing the roof nail leak on the west side, removing a couple of rocks and a tree root from the driveway and filling in some low spots in the driveway with dirt from the south side dirt mound.

- \* Junie Esslinger feels the 15” Obsession Telescope is only performing at a 13” level. Therefore we will be gathering information Junie has requested so he can determine how to advise us as to what corrections or modification are needed to achieve the 15” design, if he feels it’s possible.

Once all the archival material has been gathered it needs to be sorted and a master list of the items in the container generated so members will know what material is available and be able to quickly locate the item(s).**
- \* Jeff Luebkeman has now gotten the 12 ½” telescope running very smoothly so anyone can maneuver it very easily.
- \* November first starts our new fiscal year, which means 2026 dues are now due at this time, which are the same as last year as indicated below.
